

General Ratings Tip Sheet

C – Computer Rating

- “A rating assigned to players that reflects level of ability”
- Generated through match play
- Valid for 3 consecutive years or until a new valid NTRP level is published for players who are 59 years of age or under through the league year except for players with a published Mixed Exclusive rating (M) who choose to participate in the Adult Division.
- Valid for 2 consecutive years if over 60

B – Benchmark Rating

- Championship Benchmark (Rating Type “B”) will no longer be published although process will remain unchanged.
- Championship players will not be allowed to appeal their ratings down for one year after playing in Championship matches but will be allowed to appeal their ratings up if they otherwise qualify.

M – Mixed Exclusive

- Year-End rating assigned to players who only participate in Mixed Doubles
- Players will not get an M rating if they still have a previous valid B or C rating
- Will be asked to re-self-rate upon entering the Adult Division

S – Self-Rate

- A rating for a new player entering the program
- After completing the Self-Rate Questionnaire player will be assigned a minimum rating level – the player can play at this level, select a higher level of play or file a self-rate appeal with the Section
- Open to Dynamic Disqualification

Dynamic Rating

- The result of a player's current match averaged with up to three of their most recent dynamic results generated.
- Calculated after each match.
- May change with each match played by the player
